BRUSH CLEARANCE

All grass & weeds within 200 feet of a structure shall be cut and maintained to a maximum height of 3 inches.

Native brush and shrubs shall be trimmed up from the ground 1/3 their height and have a minimum separation of 18 feet from any structure and other native shrubs.

Native shrubs shall not be planted within 10 feet of a combustible fence or roadway.

Maintain all grass and weeds within 10 feet of a combustible fence or edge of roadway to a maximum height of 3 inches.

Branches and foliage shall be trimmed up 5 feet from any roof surface.

Branches and foliage shall be trimmed back 10 feet from outlet of the chimney.

CERT is an acronym for "Community Emergency Response Team." CERT is an all-risk all-hazard training, provided free of charge within the City of Los Angeles to anyone 18 or over.

Classes are taught year round, Monday through Friday, morning, afternoon & night.

CERT members receive 17-1/2 hours (one day a week for 7 weeks) of initial training.
